

# HOPTON CEMETERY

## NOTICE

The parish council understands the wishes of relatives and friends to remember, through floral tributes, those who are buried here.

However, we must ask you to understand that in order to keep costs of maintenance of the cemetery at a reasonable level, the rules of this cemetery only permit flowers to be placed in a pot located by prior arrangement in the base of a memorial. The only exception allowed being the placement of funeral wreaths for a time on a new grave.

Planting of grave sites causes delays in the mowing process and in order to avoid possible upset through the removal and disposal of such plants, the Parish Council hereby requests all visitors to refrain from any planting on grave sites.

Apart from flowers, plants and wreaths, no other graveside ornaments or adornments are permitted that are not an integral part of a headstone.
